ORDINANCE NO. 05022016(A)

AN ORDINANCE READOPTING RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE OPERATION AND THE USE OF PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SEWERS AND DRAINS, PRIVATE SEWAGE DISPOSAL, THE INSTALLATION AND CONNECTION OF BUILDING SEWERS, AND THE DISCHARGE OF WATERS AND WASTES INTO THE PUBLIC SEWER SYSTEM, PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF, AND AMENDING §51.01 OF THE CODE OF HAWK POINT, MISSOURI.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF HAWK POINT, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

The provisions of City Code §§51.01 through 51.08 are hereby readopted to govern the sewer services furnished by the municipality in a uniform manner for the benefit of the municipality and its sewer users. They are subject to change from time to time. All such changes must be approved by the State Director of the Rural Development, United States Department of Agriculture, or his successor, so long as the municipality has unpaid obligations which are held by or insured by the United States of America. If any portion of these Rules shall be declared invalid by competent authority, such voidance shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions.

The following definitions shall be added to Section 51.01.

Unless the context specifically indicates otherwise, the meaning of terms used in this ordinance shall be as follows:

“BOD” (denoting Biochemical Oxygen-Demand) shall mean the quantity of oxygen utilized in the biochemical oxidation of organic matter under standard laboratory procedure in five (5) days at 20° C, expressed in milligrams per liter.

“Combined Sewer” shall mean a sewer receiving both surface runoff and sewage.

“Superintendent” shall mean the Superintendent of the Municipal Sewer Works of Hawk Point, Missouri, or his authorized deputy, agent or representative. ***THIS DEFINITION SHALL REPLACE THE CURRENT DEFINITION.***

“Municipality” shall mean Hawk Point, Missouri.

“State Director” shall mean the State Director of Rural Development for Missouri, United States Department of Agriculture, or his successor.


“Applicant” shall mean any individual, firm, partnership, corporation or other agency owning land within the municipality applying for a sewer service.

“Board” shall mean the Board of Aldermen of Hawk Point, Missouri.

“Inspector” shall mean the person or persons duly authorized by the Board of Aldermen of Hawk Point, Missouri, to inspect and approve the installation of building sewers and their connection to the public sewer system.
