ORDINANCE NO. 33.06

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF HAWK POINT, MISSOURI, TO
PARTICIPATE IN THE
MULTI-COUNTY NARCOTICS AND VIOLENT CRIME ENFORCEMENT UNIT

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMAN OF THE CITY OF MOSCOW
MILLS, LINCOLN COUNTY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, fighting the proliferation of illegal drugs and narcotics crimes is one of the major health and safety concerns affecting government today; and

WHEREAS, a copy of the proposed cooperative Memorandum of Understanding and Operating Procedure Manual is attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein; and

WHEREAS, members of local law enforcement have been successful in securing various state and federal grants for the purpose of operating and sustaining a Multi-County Narcotics and Violent Crime Enforcement Unit within the unincorporated areas of Lincoln County, _____ and within those municipalities which agree to be a part this cooperative effort; and

WHEREAS, the term of the cooperative Memorandum of Understanding and Operating Procedure shall be until such time as this governing body declines further involvement in this Multi-County Narcotics and Violent Crime Enforcement Unit.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDAINED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Hawk Point, Missouri, that the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the above-referenced Memorandum of Understanding and Operating Procedure Manual on behalf of the City of Hawk Point, Missouri.

Savings Clause.

Except as expressly set forth herein, nothing contained in this ordinance shall in any manner be deemed or construed to alter, modify, supersede, supplant, or otherwise nullify any other ordinance of the city, or the requirements thereof, whether or not relating to or in any manner connected with the subject matter hereof.

Severability Clause.


If any term, condition, or provision of this ordinance shall, to any extent, be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the remainder hereof shall be valid in all other respects and continue to be effective and each and every remaining provision hereof shall be valid and shall be enforced to the fullest extent permitted by law, it being the intent of the Board of Aldermen that it would have enacted this ordinance without the invalid or unenforceable provisions. In the event of a subsequent change in applicable law so that the provisions which had been held invalid is no longer invalid, said provisions shall thereupon return to full force and effect without further action by the city and shall thereafter be binding.

Effective Date.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.
